Note by the Executive Director Emergency Assistance for Iran

- 1. As the result of the earthquake of 24 April which destroyed much of the towns of Lar and Garas in southern Iran and caused several hundred deaths and serious injuries to the population, the Government of Iran, through its United Nations Delegation, requested assistance such as UNICEF might be in position to provide. An additional request was cabled direct from Teheran on 26 April by Doctor M. Daftari, the Government's delegate to the Executive Board.
- 2. The UNICEF Country Office has been closely following developments in the area and on 28 April cabled a request for authorization to transfer immediately to the emergency area the following items from existing UNICEF project stocks in the country: 200,000 pounds of skim milk; 1,000,000 vitamin A&D capsules; 30,000 pounds of soap; and 1,000 vials of penicillin.
- 3. Permission to make the transfer was cabled to the Country Office on the same date in accordance with previous practice, and it is understood that distribution of UNICEF supplies is already under way. No UNICEF allocation is required at this time.
- 4. The UNICEF Secretariat has been in touch with voluntary agencies and it is expected that there will be substantial offers of assistance from such sources. Red Cross Societies under the guidance of the League of Red Cross Societies are providing antibiotics and dressings, tents and blankets, and a League representative has gone to Teheran for liaison with the Red Lion and Sun Organization which is co-ordinating relief for the stricken area.
