Report of the Executive Board on Approval of Emergency Relief Allocations to PHILIPPINES (Epidemic) and SOMALIA (Flood and Famine)

1. Two recommendations for emergency aid were approved by mail poll by the Executive Board in January 1962 to give the following assistance:

Philippines Epidemic of Cholera El Tor Allocation approved: \$50,000 An outbreak of cholera El Tor which started in the Philippines late in 1961 assumed epidemic proportions in January, when 10,000 cases and 1,000 deaths were reported. To assist the Government in prophylactic measures, UNICEF is providing fluids for re-hydration in the most seriously affected areas. Other medical supplies may also be required in the emergency. UNICEF aid will be co-ordinated with assistance from other sources.

Somalia Rehabilitation following Allocation approved: \$106,000 flood and famine

An estimated 320,000 children are threatened by famine and epidemics as a result of severe drought conditions in 1961 followed by persistent flooding rains over one fourth of the national territory. Emergency assistance from several governments and voluntary organizations has been co-ordinated by a relief and rehabilitation commission set up by the Prime Minister. FAO, WHO UNESCO and the United States Agency for International Development have put

staff at the disposal of the Government for relief and rehabilitation operations and the Federal Republic of Germany is providing the services of a road engineer. UNICEF assistance will be directed to emergency problems of child health and nutrition through: (a) the training of health officers, teachers and rehabilitation agents in rehabilitation planning and techniques; (b) the rebuilding of health services and the prevention of epidemics; (c) the replacement of destroyed teaching equipment in schools; and (d) the provision of food production supplies. The UNICEF allocation will be used to provide doctors' kits, drugs and vehicles for district health services; school supplies; food production supplies and seeds; and travel and subsistence stipends for 50 doctors, health workers and teachers to participate in rehabilitation seminars.
