HIGHLIGHTS OF VISIT TO PIBOR.

DATE: 24/9/96.

PARTICIPANT HUMPHREYS R. WERE RPO

PEOPLE MET : ISMAEL KONYI COMMISSIONER AND RELIEF COMMITTEE.

STAFF MEMBER-VISITED PIBOR VIA BOR ON 24/9/96 AND STAYED ON THE GROUND FOR ONE HR TO CONDUCT A RAPID ASSESSMENT OF AREA.

SETUATION

PIBOR HAS NOT BEEN ACCESSED FROM EITHER LOKI-OR KHARTOUM FOR THE LAST SIX MONTHS DUE PARTLY TO REPORTED INSECURITY, LACK OF LANDING PERMISSION AND PARTLY DUE TO HEAVY RAINS/FLOODS WHICH HAVE MADE IT IMPOSSIBLE FOR ANY ACCESS. DURING THIS PERIOD ALL RELIEF EMERGENCY SERVICES STOPPED DELIVERY OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND SERVICES, EPI ACTIVITIES, CATTLE VACCINATION, SUPPORT TO SAFE DRINKING WATER SUPPLY OF HHES-INPUTS AND ANY OTHER SERVICES ALL CAME TO A STANDSTILL.

AERIAL SURVEY SHOWED SUBMERGED VILLAGES AND CROPS CLOSE TO PIBOR RIVER AND PIBOR TOWN IS STILL HALF SURROUNDED BY WATER CROP DAMAGE IS EXTENSIVE AND ECOD SHORTAGE ANTICIPATED REPORTS OF CATTLE DEATHS FROM ESPECIALLY RINDERPEST AND OTHER DISEASE WAS REPORTED FROM VILLAGES AWAY FROM PIBOR.

THE RELIEF COMMITTEE REPORTED THAT OVER 4000 PEGPLE HAD MOVED FROM
FLOODED VILLAGES NEAR PIBOR INTO PIBOR TOWN SWELLING TOWN POPULATION
TO OVER 8000 PEOPLE. THE POPULATION IS LIVING WITHOUT ADEQUATE
SHELTERS, BLANKETS, MOSQUITO NETS AND LIMITED FOOD, MOVEMENT IS
HAMPERED BY WATER EVEN ACROSS THE RIVER. BECAUSE OF ALL THE ABOVE
DIFFICULT CONDITIONS, THE COMMITTEE REPORTED HIGH INCIDENCE OF
MALARIA, DIARRHOEA, SKIN DISEASES AND GUINEA WORM INFECTION.
MEASLES OUTBREAK WAS REPORTED IN VILLAGES AWAY FROM PIBOR. FISH
AVAILABLE BUT FISHING EQUIPMENT LIMITED.

EXISTING FACILITIES.

- THESE INCLUDE COLD CHAIN SYSTEM THAT REQUIRE MINOR REPAIRS AND SERVICES. THE SCHOOL IS ALSO IN PLACE WITH 200 STUDENTS BUT LACK
- SCHOOL MATERIALS.
- DELIVERIES PLACED INCLUDED:
- -- PHCU-KITS; -- 2; ORS-KITS-2 , CHLOROQUINE AND PANADOQ-TABLETS-1000 OF --- EACH AND 2 DRUMS DIESEL FOR WATER .

RECOMMENDATIONS: ---

- **SHELTER: SUPPLY OF BLANKETS , MOSQUITO NETS, BAXES AND SICKLES FOR BUILDING AND ANY USED CLOTHING.
- WATER SUPPLY OF JERRYCANS AND BUCKETS AND CONTINUED SUPPLY OF FUEL FOR WATER PUMP.

- > 1500 JERRY CANS/BUCKETS
