MRS AVABAI WADIA - PRESIDENT, PANILY PLANNING ASSOCIATION OF INDIA

Mrs Wadia was a founder member of the Family Planning Association of India (FPAI) in 1949, and has been its President since 1963. She has been involved in the International Planned Parenthood Federation since its establishment in 1952, and was its President from 1983 to 1989. She has been an advisor to the Indian government on health and family welfare issues and has played an instrumental role in raising the recognition of non-governmental organizations in India, and networking with them on issues of family planning and population. Mrs Wadia is the recipient of India's highest awards for service to the country, the Padma Shri and the Padma Bhushan. She is highly regarded both in India and in international circles for her promotion of family planning and has spread the message around the world in her past role as IPPF Mrs Wadia has participated in numerous United Nations and international conferences and has spoken extensively on women's issues, family welfare and family planning. She was a barrister and gained qualifications in law at London University.
