Corrigendum

Page 2 - Delete the entire paragraph under the heading "B. Leather and Textiles", and insert the following:

"B. Leather and Textiles

Wool: The total programmed for wool is \$15,000. It is planned to provide knitting wool, of which 20% will be used for the production of infants' garments for layettes, and the remainder for garments for children aged 1 - 15 years. The hand knitting will be carried out in vocational training centres and in children's institutions. The machine knitting material will be handled by the Ministry of Supply and Rationing, who will exchange it immediately for finished garments for distribution under the Ministry of Social Welfare.

Leather: The total for this programme is \$25,000. Approximately 17,000 pairs of shoes will be provided. About 20% of the leather will be used for manufacture of shoes for older children and adolescents in vocational training centres. The remaining approximately 80% will be exchanged by the Ministry of Supply and Rationing for boots and shoes already manufactured, which will be distributed through the Ministry of Social Welfare.

"Distribution: Distribution will be made to children in institutions and camps. A minimum of 15% of the total distribution will be allocated to the Arab population. It is believed that the distribution can be completed in the early part of 1951."
